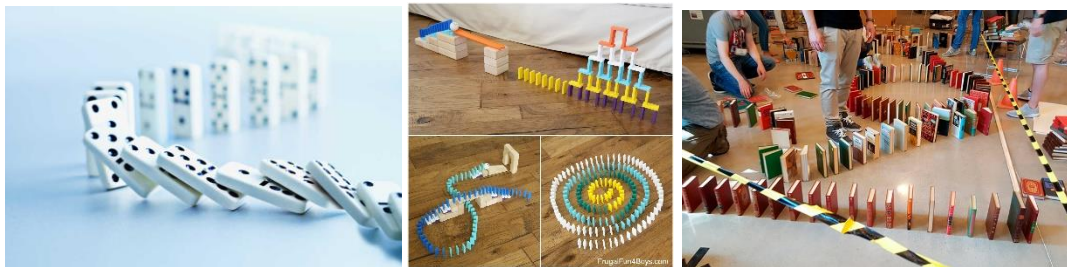
PE
